



Forfeits

A forfeiture of a game will result in a 1 to 0 win for the opponents.

The forfeit fines are below:

- More than 48 hours' notice to the NSISL: \$100.00
- 24 hours – 48 hours' notice to the NSISL: \$150.00
- Less than 24 hours' notice to the NSISL: \$200.00

Playoff forfeits:

- More than 48 hours' notice to the NSISL: \$200.00
- 24 hours – 48 hours' notice to the NSISL: \$250.00
- Less than 24 hours' notice to the NSISL: \$300.00

The penalty for repeated forfeitures is possible expulsion from the league (no refunds will be issued) or preclusion of the team from registering with the league for future seasons.

For greater certainty, a forfeit is considered to be when a team:

- (i) Fails to show up for the game
- (ii) Fails to produce the required minimum number of players by the start of the game
- (iii) Knowingly plays unregistered players
- (iv) Notifies the league of its intention to forfeit



The league is not responsible for the teams' forfeit games, and will not reschedule forfeited games, or provide financial compensation in lieu of the game to the team that was forfeited on.

The forfeit fine **MUST** be paid prior to anyone on the team continuing to play in the league or registering to play in the upcoming seasons with the league.
